

# Genesis Reading Plan

This month's reading plan is broken up into four weeks, with each daily reading followed by a reflection question. Read the full chapter to gain context for reflection and meditation of God's word.

## Week 1                      Origins                      September 5-10

**Day 1** Genesis 1

*What can we learn about the Trinity in light of Genesis 1 & John 1?*

**Day 2** Genesis 2

*What was the only thing that God said was not good? Why?*

**Day 3** Genesis 3

*How does the initial question from the serpent, then God compare?*

**Day 4** Genesis 4

*Consider the manipulative effect of sin. Then read 1 John 3:11-18*

**Day 5** Genesis 5

*Consider the words spoken over Noah at birth. (Fun facts: Adam lived to see Lamech born. Methusaleh, known as the oldest human, died in the flood.)*

**Day 6** Genesis 6

*Consider Hebrews 11:1-8. Fill in the blank: By faith, (your name) did...*

*What do you gather from comparing Psalm 25:14 to this chapter?*

**Day 2** Genesis 8

*What will never cease while the earth remains? Read Psalm 29*

**Day 3** Genesis 9

*What is the symbol of the covenant God made? Compare Gen. 1:27-28*

**Day 4** Genesis 10

*Consider God's mercy and covenant of peace also in Isa. 54:9-14*

**Day 5** Genesis 11

*What was rebellious about the intention of the Tower?*

**Day 6** Genesis 12

*Compare Abram's instruction & the intent of the Tower. Acts 7:2-8*
